

CRESTON VALLEY FLYING CLUB CONSTITUTION & BY-LAWS

ARTICLE I

The name of this organization shall be the “CRESTON VALLEY FLYING CLUB”, hereinafter called the “Club”. The Club shall be registered as a Society under the Society Act of British Columbia.

ARTICLE II

The purpose of the Club shall be to encourage and promote low cost flying in the Creston Valley; to foster fellowship and comradery within the aviation community in the Creston Valley through the promotion of social events; to promote aviation in general; and to enhance and promote the Creston Valley airport.

ARTICLE III

Meetings of the Club shall be held as follows: regular general meetings - the 1st Thursday of every month; annual general meetings - the 1st Thursday in March each year; Directors meetings - as required.

Quorum - 6 authorized (paid) members shall constitute a quorum for any general meeting.

ARTICLE IV

Membership shall be open to any person interested in the promotion of general aviation. Members must be of good moral character, responsible and financially able to meet the obligations of the Club. The duties of the members shall be to conduct themselves in a proper and fitting manner; to uphold the dignity of the Club on the flying field; to be alert and mindful of the Club’s interests; to exercise caution and safety in flying; and to observe all D.O.T., FAA, and Club rules and regulations
All new members must be approved by the Board of Directors by a simple majority vote.

ARTICLE V

The Club shall elect a Board of Directors consisting of a President, Vice-president, Secretary-Treasurer and three directors at large. All officers terms shall be for one year. Two directors at large shall be elected for one-year terms and one director shall be elected for a two-year term. The Secretary-Treasurer shall not be assessed any membership dues during the year.

ARTICLE VI

The fiscal year of the Club shall be the year ending January 31st

ARTICLE VII

The constitution and by-laws may be changed by amendment passed at any general meeting by a vote of 75% of the majority of members present.
